Purim tochnit, year 7-8 girls: woman leadership and beauty

Introduction:

We show the girls parts of the movies "Mulan" and "Shrek". In "Mulan" we show the part where she tries to become a bride but is a disgrace to her family. 10 Min.

The girls are divided in to 5 groups that have about 10 girls per group

Each station will take 10 Min.

Station 1: Test yourself- are you a leader/beautiful/both - 2 questionnaires

- a. The students will get few pssukim (appendix 1) from the Megila about beauty and leadership and they will need to arrange them according to what is more important, what do they think helped Ester the most on a scale from 1-10. There can be more than one passuk on each number. At this point the madricha spreads on the floor the different pssukim and asks the girls to do so. There is no discussion yet.
- b. The girls need to add up the points in each test; the madricha will read the conclusion of what it means and open a discussion.
 - Did the test really reflect who you really are?
 - What do you think is your stronger side?
 - Are you satisfied with your results?
 - How does the order of the psukim reflect your opinion?

Station 2: The worlds idols-

we spread on the floor different pictures of female movie stars that haven't accomplished many meaningful things in their lives and pictures of famous woman that have accomplished meaningful things in there lives such as: Rosa Parks, Madam Karri, Golda Meir, Hilary Clinton, Nechama Lebowich and more. We ask the girls to tell us all the information they know about these characters. We will see that they know A LOT about the movie stars but almost nothing at all about the other woman.

Discussion- on what does our society put more of an emphasis- beauty or leadership?

- How do you know so much about these movie stars?
- What is so interesting about them? What makes you want to know information about their life?
- If you would have next to you the "woman's weekly" magazine and the Rosa Parks biography book, what would you choose to read? Why?
- What does that say about us?
- What does each character represent? (beauty/leadership-accomplishments)

Station 3: Beauty inside out-

We show the girls a few commercials where you see a pretty girl that doesn't really have anything to do with the product being sold).

After that we spread on the floor cards that have on them pictures of 6 or 7 woman- some pretty and some not, 6 or 7 jobs- some good and some not, number of children, names- some nice and some not, neighbourhood etc.

The girls need to organize the cards according to how they think it really is. They will probably put a pretty girl with a nice name and good job etc. where did we get that kind of thinking from?

We will then show the girls the picture that is the old woman and young woman in one face. (Appendix 2)

- Why did u organize the cards the way you did?
- What does the commercial show?
- What does the model have to do with the product she is advertising?
- How did the commercial affect the way you set the cards?
- How did we get to the point where beauty defines who we are and what we are worth?
- What can we learn from the picture of the old and young ladies?
- So can we see from this that if there are two people with the exact same abilities, the pretty one will be chosen?
- We can see this idea (that women are more that external looks) from Vashti's actions. Why did vashti refuse to come to the men's side? What point is she trying to make?

Station 4: leadership types

Four girls are chosen to act four different type of people:

- ✓ The popular one- cares mostly about her looks.
- ✓ The nerd one.
- ✓ The quite one.
- ✓ The rebellious one.

Each girl presents her character and the rest of the girls need to vote on who they would choose to lead their country. We ask the girls why her and what defines a leader. This shows the girls that almost anyone can be a leader; all you need is the right balance between the different characteristics- compare to queen Ester.

- Why did u choose her to lead?
- Can the rest of the girls do the job as well?
- Is she the ultimate leader?
- What does a leader need? What characteristics does a leader have?
- What characteristic can we use from each girl?
- Do we as individuals have the right characteristics to be leaders?
- Was queen Ester born a leader?
- What caused queen Ester to take initiative and become a leader?
- What does that teach us about ourselves?

At this point the madricha shows the process ester went through as when she needed to take action.

Station 5: make overs

The girls are divided into two groups with 5 girls per group. Each group gets a long paper the size of a real person. They need to draw around one of the girls and then draw and colour her in so she is the prettiest "model". The madricha will choose the wining team.

Then each girl decorates a cookie/muffin. We don't need to be on a diet all day!!!!!! ©

Conclusion – all students return to MPR :

In Shrek the scene in the end where Shrek and Fiona get married and she is supposed to turn beautiful and Shrek tells her she is beautiful.



If you got between 0-12 points:
